For your protection, omit the following items when packing:

- Aerosol cans regardless of content
- Heating agents such as Sterno
- Nail polish/remover
- Fire extinguisher
- Any type of gas in bottles or tanks including propane or oxygen
- Paints, varnishes, solvents, thinners and oils
- Ammonia, bleach and other household cleaning agents
- Chlorine granules or powder
- Muriatic acid (also called hydrochloric acid)
- Auto batteries
- Charcoal/lighter fluid
- Matches and lighters
- Ammunition
- Any other combustible product

In addition to hazardous materials, perishable items and those of personal importance are recommended for your individual transport. These include, but are not limited to:

- Frozen/refrigerated food
- Produce
- Open food items
- Plants
- Prescription medications
- Stocks, bonds and securities
- Collections, such as coins and stamps
- Insurance policies
- Currency
- Jewelry and furs
- Other important documents

A safe move is the only move for your family. Proper planning and exclusion of hazardous items during the packing process will help make your move a satisfying experience.
